Flevoland, Holland The concert went well. I sensed that we had really connected with the audience. I could see it in their eyes. Afterwards, Jimmy and I went to the concession table to meet people. It was fantastic! So many interesting comments - and the language...the Dutch have a gift for speaking English in a way that actually makes it sound romantic. I talked to two young Dutch girls, Marlou and Evelien for the longest time. They were so full of life and love and hope. I told them they must come to America and stay with us.

The next morning while returning from a Dutch radio broadcast we drove past a large open field. I could see Marlou and Evelien. Marlou was dancing wildly and singing while Evelien followed close by. Just as our car passed them my eyes met with those of Marlou. She stopped her dance and the melody ceased. I wanted to roll down the window and yell, "No, no, no! Don't stop dancing! Don't stop singing! To see you dance and sing is my joy! Don't be afraid, be the child that you are. Never stop being so free, so full of life. Don't let these eyes take away your freedom. Never!"

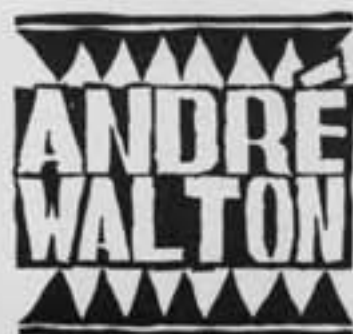
